



Major event undertaken by AMO in 2023

- 1) Ayurvedic Medical Organization (AMO in association with National Ayurveda Students and Youth Association (NASYA Assam Chapter) organized a Day Long Seminar on Pharmacovigilance for Ayurvedic Practitioners at the seminar hall of Govt Ayurvedic College and Hospital, Guwahati, Assam on 25/03/2023 (Saturday) supported by All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), New Delhi. The resource team for the seminar was from three premium institutes from the North Eastern region. Ayurvedic practitioners from different districts of Assam participated in the program. Union Minister for Ministry of AYUSH, Govt of India Shri Sarbananda Sonowal also extended his warm greeting through a video message for the program.
- 2) Women's Day Free Health camp was organized on 12/03/2023 at Dibrugarh Assam.
- 3) Free Health camp organized (12/03/2023) in relation with International Women's Day, 2023 at Sankardev Sisu Niketan, Sapatgram, Dhubri in collaboration with Brihattar Sapatgram Mahila Eikya Mancha where 68 patients are checked-up and free medicines distributed.
- 4) On the occasion of International Women's Day 2023, AMO in association with Dr Hedgewar Smarak Samiti organized an awareness program on the Ayurvedic approach to Women's Health issues on 19/03/2023 at Sudarshanalya Guwahati. Renowned Ayurvedic expert Dr. Neeta Mahesekar Madam, Director NEIAH Shillong delivered a talk on women's health, Dr. Nilima Goswami talked regarding the role of mothers/women in a better and healthier society, Chief Guest for this occasion was Dr. Sunita Changkakoti, Chairperson, Assam State Commission for Protection of Child Rights.
- 5) The free Ayurvedic treatment camp was organized on 24/03/2023 with 180 patients in Dhekiajuli, Sonitpur district in conjunction with International Women's Day.
- 6) A free Healthcheck-up camp was organized by AMO in association with Sukleshwar Medhi Memorial Foundation on 09/05/2023 at Barbhag, Nalbari district.
- 7) A free Eye check-up camp and yoga practice camp was organized by Sukleshwar Medhi Memorial Foundation and AMO on 28/07/2023 at Balitara, Nalbari district.
- 8) Free Swarnaprasan camp organized at Nalbari Satra MV School on 15/08/2023. 45 nos of children are benefited.
- 9) A free Ayurvedic medical and health camp has been organized by AMO along with Sewa Bharati on 24/09/2023 at BORPETABORI LP school, Morigaon. More than 100 patients were consulted and free Ayurvedic medicines were distributed.
- 10) Ayurvedic Medical Organization in collaboration with Dr. B. Baruah Cancer Institute, Guwahati organized a day-long seminar on 'Prevention of Cancer through Screening and Early Detection' on 28/09/2023 in conjunction with the Platinum Jubilee of Government Ayurvedic College, Guwahati was organized. The closing ceremony was attended by HE Governor Shri Golap Chand Kataria and Hon'ble Minister of Health, Government of Assam Shri Keshav Mahanta. He also appreciated the social work being done by AMO. Director of AYUSH and Joint Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department Smt. Indranoshee Das, Principal of Government Ayurvedic College Dr. Pranabjyoti Baishya, and Professors of Ayurvedic College were also present. Guwahati CCRAS Director Dr. Dinesh Baruah and Joint Director of Health Services, Kamrup District Dr Kandarpa Das were also present. The workshop was attended by more than 200 Ayurvedic doctors, teachers and students. 5 senior doctors from Dr. B. Baruah Cancer Institute, Guwahati and 2 senior doctors from Government Ayurvedic College, Guwahati gave lectures in the workshop.

- 11) In September 2023, AMO in association with Seva Bharati organized around **50 no's Poshan Maah** (Nutritional Month) awareness program across Assam at the Village and Block level.
- 12) AMO and ESIC_Model Hospital Beltola, Guwahati organized Cleanliness Campaign in Khanapara, Guwahati on 01/10/2023.
- 13) A free health check-up camp was organized at Sankardev Sishu/ Vidya Niketan, Beltola, Guwahati on 07/10/2023 and around 600 students were examined and free Ayurvedic medicines were distributed.


**AYURVEDIC MEDICAL ORGANIZATION (AMO), ASSAM CELEBRATES






